Who are we? Calgary Emergency Management Agency


- Coordinates the response of multiple Agency members and partners when a disaster or major event occurs

Pandemic, COVID -19

- The COVID-19 pandemic has been an unprecedented situation for not only Calgary, but the entire World
- Alberta saw the first presumptive COVID-19 case occur a year ago on March 5th, within the Calgary zone
- The Calgary zone has seen over 50,844 COVID-19 cases and sadly over 577 deaths to date, with both numbers continuing to grow
- As we start to see the economy reopen, slowly, the public compliance to public health orders will be critical to prevent further infection


